The AMERICAN BICYCLE ASSOCIATION would like to invite you to attend the ABA BMX Cajun Nationals, to be held at the Lamar-Dixon Expo Center, April 27 - 29, 2007. The Lamar-Dixon Expo Center is located at 9039 St. Landry Road in Gonzales, LA. Exit I-10 at Exit 177 - LA Hwy 30 Exit West (towards Tanger Mall) then Left onto St. Landry Road.

Bicycle Motocross (BMX) is a sport for the entire family. The event will attract approximately 600 amateur and professional competitors from more than 40 states, as well as foreign competitors from all over the world. Competitors will range in age from "barely-off-training-wheels" 5 year olds to the "old men" of the 56 & over cruiser class. The entire dirt course will measure up to 1,100 feet long, scattered with massive jumps of all shapes and sizes.

The American Bicycle Association is also a proud supporter of the 2008 Olympic Games in Beijing, China, where BMX Racing will make its Olympic debut. Top professional and amateur Olympic hopefuls will be in attendance.

FRIDAY will consist of Practice from 3-6:00pm and a pre-race, which begins at 6:00pm and runs until approximately 8:00pm.

SATURDAY is the first day of the ABA Cajun Nationals. Racing begins at 10:30am and will conclude at approximately 2:00pm.

SUNDAY will cap off the weekends festivities with day 2 of the ABA Cajun Nationals. Racing begins at 8:00am sharp and will be over by approximately 12:00pm.
